

## FREEDOM RIDGE RULES

This list of rules is intended to keep all safe and maximize everyone's enjoyment of their visit to Freedom Ridge. Please be careful and use common sense, be sure others do also.

- All off road vehicles must pass basic tech inspection (see website for details).
- No two wheel drive or "sport" atv's allowed.
- · No three wheelers or dirt bikes allowed.
- No reckless driving, violators will be asked to leave.
- No speeding in campground 10 MPH speed limit will be strictly enforced.
- Be respectful of our grass, no donuts, digging holes, burnouts etc.
- No motorized vehicles are allowed to run from 7pm till
  7am, this includes golf carts, utv's, atv's, cars & trucks
- Quiet time from 1am to 7am, please be respectful of others.
- Wristbands to be worn at all times, missing or lost wristbands will need to leave or immediately purchase a new wristband.
- Must have a valid ID card on person to be consuming alcohol.
- No underage drinking allowed, police will be called to enforce.
- · All children must be supervised.

- No weapons allowed.
- No fighting will be tolerated.
- Stay on property, crossing onto neighboring properties will result in ejection from Freedom Ridge.
- Pets must be on a leash and under control at all times.
  Pet waste must be cleaned up!
- Camp fires are allowed, must be under 3' in height and width.
- Generators are allowed from 8am till 10pm.
- Campsite MUST be left clean of any debris, trash receptacles are provided.
- Must have a valid ATV safety certificate and be of legal age to operate ATV.
- Please respect all local laws when in town of Atwater
  1 mile from Freedom Ridge, local police and county
  Sheriff patrol the town and surrounding roads.
- Violation of any of the rules could result in ejection from Freedom Ridge and/or police being called.
